STATEMENT OF WORK (SOW)
SUPPORT TO THE NORTH AND SOUTH SUDAN DDR COMMISSIONS PROJECT:
MOTORBOATS & Accessories

OBJECTIVE

In supporting Canada’s commitment to enhance technical and operational capacity of South Sudan DDR Commission (SSDDRC) to undertake its mandate, the Canadian Commercial Corporation (CCC), in partnership with the Department of Foreign Affairs and International Trade (DFAIT) invites interested companies to provide a bid for the provisioning of motorboats as outlined below.

BACKGROUND

The Comprehensive Peace Agreement signed by both the Government of Sudan and Sudan People’s Liberation Army/Movement (SPLA/M) on 9 January 2005 calls for a nationally owned DDR Programme. However, while the operational costs of both Commissions are being borne by both Governments, field level engagement and consultations have revealed that there still remains a significant gap and need for the strengthening of organizational and strategic development within the respective institutions to a level whereby they are capable of assuming the full responsibility for independently sustaining the programme at both the policy and working levels.

This SOW details the motorboats that will be procured and provided to the SSDDRC, based in Juba, Sudan, as part of the capacity enhancing initiative.

EQUIPMENT TO BE PROCURED

Motorboats and accessories are being procured for SSDDRC, and are as follows:

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

Boats: Quantity of 10 utility motorboats for the transportation of a minimum of 10 passengers

- Stainless Steel Bow & Stern (with drain plug)
- Payload: minimum 1000 kilos
- Seating Capacity: minimum 10 passengers
- Full length removable Canopy
- Removable Bench Seats & Rear Seat

Each boat is to be equipped accordingly with the following:

- Outboard Engine: Minimum 40 HP
- Anchor Hatch & Anchor
- Wooden paddles
- 10 lifejackets
- Trailer and suitable hitch for towing

Accessories: to provide all required consumables and spare parts sufficient for 2 years of operations for boat and equipment.

Warranty.

Suppliers are to provide warranties on the major components of equipment for a minimum of 24 months from delivery date. Suppliers are to clearly detail what will be covered by warranty and what is excluded as part of their proposal. Additionally, suppliers are to provide a list of repair locations in Africa for their warranty service requirements.

Operator and maintenance manuals.

The supplier is to include operator and maintenance manuals for equipment, in Arabic and/or English.

Training requirements. Nil.

Delivery requirements.

The equipment is to be delivered directly to Juba, Sudan. CCC is in discussion with the SSDDRC and the UNDP in Sudan concerning designating a point of contact within Sudan to receive the material being shipped, as well as the exact timings when the deliveries will be required. Suppliers should note that the deliveries are to occur no later than 30 September 2010, however deliveries will be acceptable as soon as a contractual agreement becomes effective. CCC will provide the Contact name and delivery timings. The bids are to include the costs of shipping on a DDP basis of all items procured under this SOW.
